Regional Issues, Innovations, and Opportunities

background

- climate related disease: malaria meningitis ...
- economy: rainfed agriculture, exposure (normal)
- vulnerability: limited economical resources, response
- urban planning: megacities not well planned
- population birth rate : highest

Climate

- temperature increase : + heat waves, hotter days
- more extreme weather events (temp, wind, rainfall drought/flooding):
- hot spots: drought + high temperature: conflict, exodus, food insecurity,

opportunity

- renewable energy (solar, wind ...)
- Political awareness and will (democracy, gender equity, education), more regional entity (AU, ecowas),
- More access drugs : cure exists but not accessible
- Stronger climate forecast: Early Warning System (ACASIS, NOAA/African Desk)
